



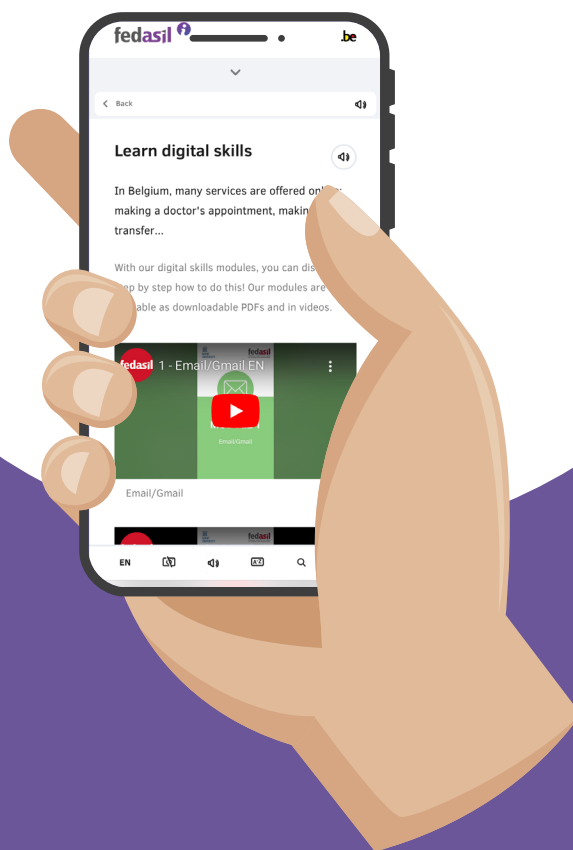
Digital skills
